What will I need to take part on the course?

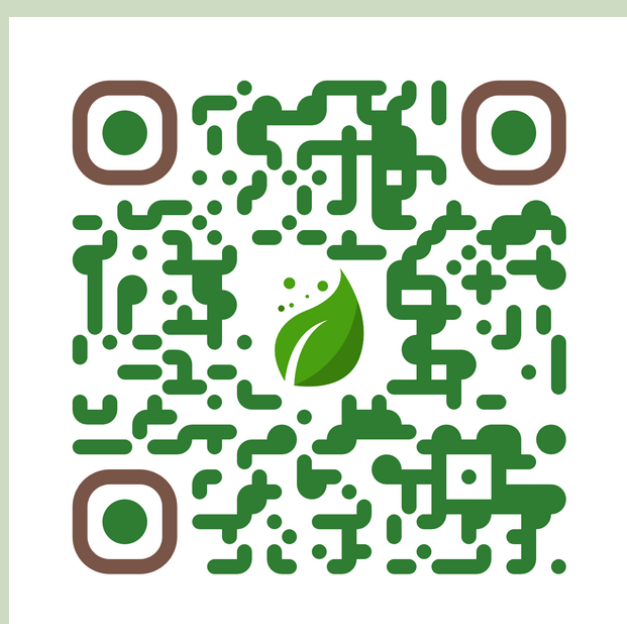
You will need waterproof clothing, appropriate footwear, hat and gloves and plenty of layers! - If cold!!
