



# Children's Wild Tribe First Aid Course

Our Children's **Wild Tribe First Aid Course** has been written in line with the RSE statutory DFE guidance which states that all children should have knowledge and understanding of first aid by the end of year 6 in primary schools (RSE 2019)

The **one-day** Wild Tribe First Aid course will be delivered in the outdoors.

- *Concepts of basic first-aid, for example dealing with common injuries, including head injuries, legs, arms and other ailments.*
- *Children will learn the basics of first aid and how to respond in an emergency*
- *Children will learn how to use bandages, slings and make a temporary stretcher*
- *The children will be taken through scenarios and learn how to administer first aid in the outdoors.*
- *All children will receive a certificate on the day*
